### **2023 Construction Projects**

- Roads
  - Reconstruction
  - Overlay
- Subdivisions
  - Rehabilitation
- Hamlets
  - Rehabilitation
- Projected to be ~ \$6.0 million in construction
- Based on the scope of work the program is procured over two tenders.
  - Tenders are posted on The Alberta Purchasing Connection (APC)
  - Leduc County road construction procurement process follows Alberta Transportation standards and procedures


## **2023** Construction Projects cont.

- Township Road 510, Nisku Spine Road to Range Road 243
- Bridge Maintenance Program (design & delivery)
  - Bridge Inspection & Maintenance System (BIM)
  - 2023 annual maintenance program consists of 8 bridges.
  - Three bridge replacements in 2023
  - Projected to be ~ \$2.1 million in construction.
- Utilities
  - Nisku west pump house upgrade

  - 25 Avenue to 30 Avenue, Nisku
  - Airport Road to 18 Avenue, Nisku
